Hayes argues that we are in the midst of an epoch-defining transition whose only parallel is what happened to labor in the nineteenth century: attention has become a commodified resource extracted from us, and from which we are increasingly alienated. *The Sirens' Call* is the book that snaps everything into a single holistic framework so that we can wrest back control of our lives, our politics, and our future.
