Narcan Training

Wednesday, January 11 @ 6pm

Narcan is the brand name of the generic naloxone and is a life-saving medication that can reverse an overdose from opioids - including heroin, fentanyl, and prescription medications - when given in time. This Free Narcan training will provide participants with a brief training on how to recognize an opioid overdose, when and how to use Narcan, and a free kit to take home. This training is provided by clinicians within the Greater Boroughs Partnership for Health.

Author Talk: Bob Young's "Walk to Wachusett with Thoreau"

Join us for this presentation by local researcher and author Bob Young, who reenacted Henry David Thoreau's walk to Mount Wachusett from Concord in 1842. Consisting of a three-day excursion through the towns of Concord, Acton, Stow, Bolton, Lancaster, Sterling, West Sterling, East Princeton, and Princeton, Bob's walk is believed to be the first complete recorded re-enactment of Thoreau's journey. The presentation will provide historical background information followed by a series of pictures and explanations of what he found and learned along Thoreau's route.
